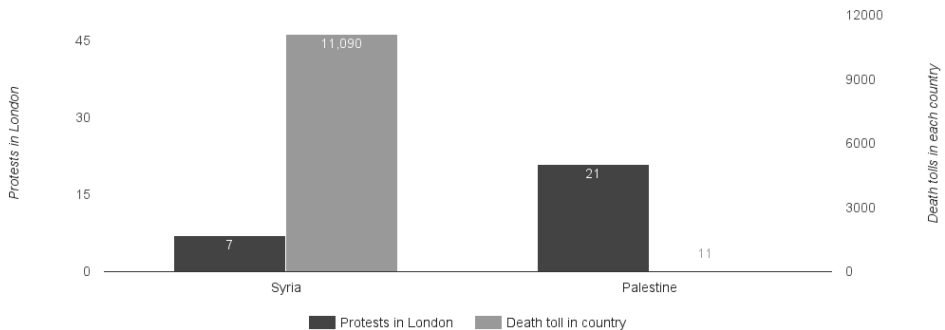


The Israel / Palestine conflict has one of the lowest death tolls in the Middle East

By June this year 11,090 people had tragically been slaughtered in Syria, in response 7 protests were organised in London. In the same period there were 11 deaths in Palestine which prompted three times as many protests in London. This means on average 1,500 people have to die before Londoners would protest against the slaughter in Syria, but only two needs to in Palestine. A crude calculation would value the life of one Palestinian as equivalent to 750 Syrians to these protesters... why?
