The Israel/Palestine conflict created twice as many Jewish refugees as it did Palestinian. When the Arab armies invaded Israel many Arabs chose to leave (they're now known as the refugees). Unlike the Palestinians many Jews in Arab lands did not have a choice to stay, but were expelled. The victims of this ethnic cleansing remain unfunded, uncompensated and to most people, unheard of.

Israel made huge efforts to absorb and integrate the Jewish refugees, while most of the Arab states went out of their way to oppress and persecute the Palestinian refugees - refusing them the right to work, travel or own properties. Locking them in poverty and refusing them the same rights as their citizens.



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
