Israel went to great lengths to save civilians in Gaza

Israel offered Hamas a ceasefire at the start of the conflict

Hamas rejected it... fought for 50 days then agreed to an almost identical one. Had they accepted the first no one would have died

ISRAEL MINIMISES CIVILIAN CASUALTIES



FLYER DROPS

Israel dropped **410,000 flyers** into Gaza to warn civilians of strikes against terror targets in their area.



PHONE CALLS AND TEXTS

In addition to the flyers, thousands of phone calls and text messages were made warning of impending strikes against buildings that were used to hide weapons.



ROOF KNOCKING

In addition to calls, thousands of non-lethal warning shots were fired above buildings to give civilians time to escape... ***unfortunately Hamas took this as an opportunity to send hundreds of children clambering onto rooftops to act as human shields for the weapons.***



ABORTING STRIKES

When the IDF saw civilians that could potentially be killed in the strike, they would abort the mission.

Name another army that goes to such lengths to protect civilians



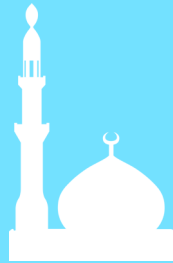
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HAMAS USES HUMAN SHIELDS

HAMAS FIRED HUNDREDS OF
ROCKETS FROM CIVILIAN AREAS



260 Rockets
fired from schools



160 Rockets
fired from mosques



127 Rockets
fired from cemeteries



50 Rockets
fired from hospitals

Hamas cares more about attacking Israel than protecting its civilians



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HAMAS LAUNCHED 54 ROCKETS FROM SCHOOLS

This Shuja'iyya school complex is one of the many schools that Hamas used to store or fire rockets. They even used schools operated by the United Nations Relief Work Agency, who publicly condemned Hamas for hijacking their facilities.



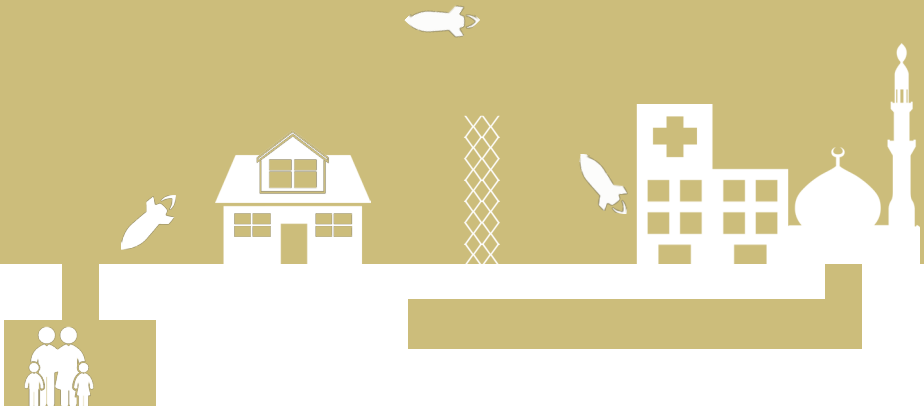
HAMAS BUILT TERROR TUNNELS INSTEAD OF SCHOOLS



The average cost for UNRWA to build a school in Gaza is \$1.8 million.
Hamas spent \$90 million digging terror tunnels to attack Israel.

For the same budget they could have built 50 schools.

While Israel invests in technology designed to save its civilian population (bomb shelters and the Iron Dome). Hamas invests in weapons designed to kill Israeli civilians, weapons it protects by hiding behind its civilians.



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ISRAEL PROVIDES MEDICAL TREATMENT

Despite Hamas firing over 4,800 rockets into Israel during the 2014 Gaza conflict. During this period Israel still admitted 1,700 residents of Gaza into Israel for treatment in its medical centres.

Does any other nation admit and treat civilians of an enemy they are at war with?

Israel makes no exceptions to this ideal and a few months after the Gaza conflict it famously admitted the daughter of Ismail Haniyeh, the then leader of Hamas, into Israel for treatment in a Tel Aviv hospital.



HAMAS DID NOT CEASE FIRE

July 15

Humanitarian ceasefire accepted.

Hamas fired 56 rockets at Israel.

July 17

5-hour humanitarian ceasefire accepted.

Hamas fired rockets at Israel.

July 20

2-hour humanitarian window in the Shuja'iyya area accepted.

Hamas violated the ceasefire.

July 26-27

Israel accepted UN-requested humanitarian ceasefire. 6 hours later, Hamas announced a 24 hour ceasefire of their own.

Hamas fired rockets at Israel violating its own ceasefire.

July 28

Hamas' asks for a ceasefire for the Muslim holiday Eid al-Fitr, Israel accepts.

Hamas fired rockets at Israel.

Aug 1

72-hour humanitarian ceasefire accepted

Hamas killed 2 soldier and kidnapped another.

Aug 4

7-hour humanitarian window authorised.

Hamas fired rockets at Israel.

Aug 5-8

Egyptian proposed 72-hour ceasefire accepted by Israel. IDF forces exit Gaza.

Hamas fired rockets at Israel.

Aug 11-13

Humanitarian ceasefire initiated by Israel.

Hamas fired rockets at Israel.

Aug 19

24-hour ceasefire accepted.

Hamas fired rockets at Israel.



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
